

CONSTITUTION AND BYLAWS

Amended October 14, 2014

Sec. 1 The name of this organization shall be called the Davis County Retired School Personnel Association and hereafter in the constitution and bylaws may be referred to as DCRSPA.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

Sec. 1 The purpose of this organization shall be the promotion of the educational, social, and economic welfare of its members.

ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

Sec. 1 Any retired employee of the nation's schools shall be eligible for membership, including retired public librarians.

Sec. 2 Associate membership shall be open to the spouses of members of the DCRSPA and any person currently employed in education.

Sec. 3 Associate members shall not have the right to hold an office but may vote.

ARTICLE IV - DUES

Sec. 1 The annual dues of members of this Association shall be \$10.00. Dues are payable on or before the meeting in September.

Sec. 2 Associate member dues are \$5.00 and shall be paid at the same time as their spouses DCRSPA dues.

ARTICLE V - ORGANIZATION OF UNIT

Sec. 1 Twenty-five percent of the members of the DCRSPA must be members of the Iowa State Retired School Personnel Association.

ARTICLE VI - OFFICERS

Sec. 1 Officers:

Officers of the DCRSPA shall be President, Vice President, Past President, Secretary and Treasurer & Secretary.

Sec. 2 Elections:

A. All officers shall be elected yearly at the May meeting.

B. Officers so elected shall take office after the last meeting of the school year.

Sec. 3 Nominating:

The President shall appoint a nominating committee of three (3) no later than February 1, to present a slate of officers at the April meeting. Additional nominations may be made from the floor. However, no nomination shall be made without the consent of the person being nominated.

Sec. 4 Duties of officers:

A. Duties of President:

- 1. Serve as Chairman of the Executive Board
- 2. Preside at the meetings of DCRSPA
- 3. Call special meetings
- 4. Appoint committees

B. Duties of Vice President:

- 1. Assist the President
- 2. Assume the duties of the President in the event the President is unable to serve.

C. Duties of Secretary:

- 1. Keep the minutes of all meetings of the Executive Board and DCRSPA
- 2. The secretary is responsible for most correspondence from DCRSPA.

D. Duties of Treasurer:

- 1. Receive and keep a record of all monies paid to DCRSPA
- 2. Pay all bills authorized by DCRSPA or the Executive Board
- 3. Work closely with the President and Membership chairpersons
- 4. Send DCRSPA dues to Iowa Retired School Personnel Association

ARTICLE VII - COMMITTEES

Sec.1 Standing committees of the DCRSPA shall be:

- A. Membership
- B. Legislative
- C. Auditing
- D. Health Education
 - E. Nominating
- F. Public Relations
 - G. Cards

ARTICLE VIII - MEETINGS

Sec. 1 The regular meetings of DCRSPA shall be held August through December, and March through the end of school year.

Sec. 2 Regular monthly meetings of DCRSPA will be held on the first Tuesday of each month excluding the first meeting and the last meeting, as they will coincide with the beginning and end of the school year. In election years the meetings will take place on the second Tuesday of November.

ARTICLE IX - EXECUTIVE BOARD

Sec. 1 The elected officers and the Past President shall serve as the Executive Board.

Sec. 2 The Executive Board will meet when deemed necessary by the DCRSPA President. The Executive Board is responsible for organizing the DCRSPA program booklet.

ARTICLE X - AFFILIATION

Sec. 1 The DCRSPA shall have an affiliation with the Iowa and National Retired School Personnel Associations and maintain a close relationship with the Iowa State Education Association.

ARTICLE XI - AMENDMENTS

Sec. 1 The Constitution and Bylaws may be amended by a majority of votes cast. Members may cast a vote at a regular DCRSPA meeting or by a sent-in vote or

Sec. 2 Other committees may be created as the Executive Board deems necessary and expedient.

e-mail ballot vote prior to the meeting. Before any amendment can be acted upon, the members must have been notified at least two weeks prior to the vote.

Sec. 1 In all matters not specifically expressed in this Constitution, the parliamentary authority shall be Robert's Rules of Order, Revised.

ARTICLE XII - PARLIAMENTARY AUTHORITY

ARTICLE XIII – DISPOSITION OF ASSETS

Sec. 1 In the event that the Davis County Retired School Personnel Association needs to be dissolved, all the assets shall be transferred to the Davis County School Support Foundation.
